<b>Understanding Numbers</b>		
Read, write and say whole numbers up to one million.		
I can read, write and say decimal numbers to two places.		
I can order whole numbers.		
I can order decimal numbers.		
I can explain what each digit in a whole and decimal number represents (place value).		
I can count on from any given number in steps (including decimals and negative numbers).		
I can explain the 'pattern' in our number system.		
I can discuss numbers using most of their properties (odd, even, factors, multiples, prime, composite, value, positive, negative, whole and decimal)		
<b>Basic Number Facts – Instant recall</b>		
I know my addition number facts to 20.		
I know my subtraction number facts to 20.		
I can apply my knowledge of the addition and subtraction number facts to 20 to bigger numbers (e.g. $400+600$ or $1300+700=$ ).		
I know my multiplication tables to $10 \times 10$ .		
I know my division facts for the multiples of numbers to 10.		
I can multiply and divide whole numbers and decimals by 10, 100 and 1000 (using my tables knowledge).		

Regularly reflect on your progress in this area and set yourself new goals. These targets are very important and help you when working in other areas of Maths.
