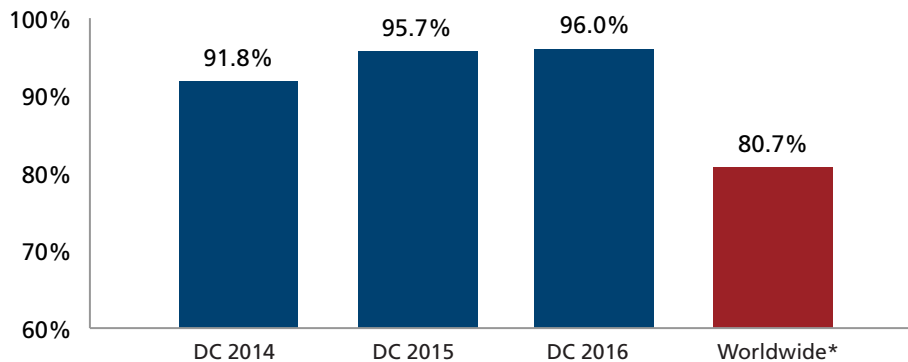


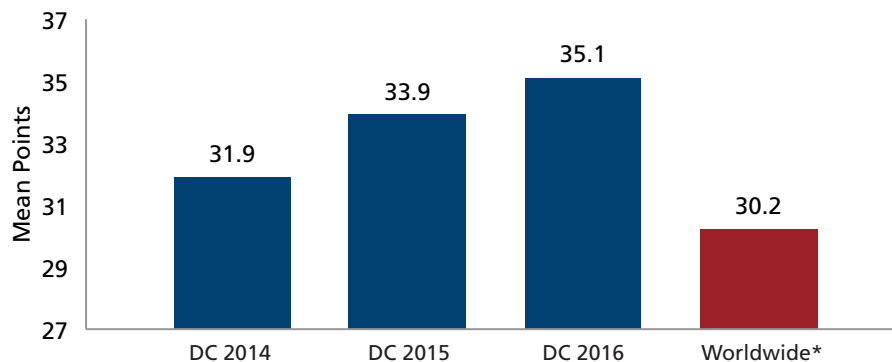
IB Diploma Provisional Results: May 2016

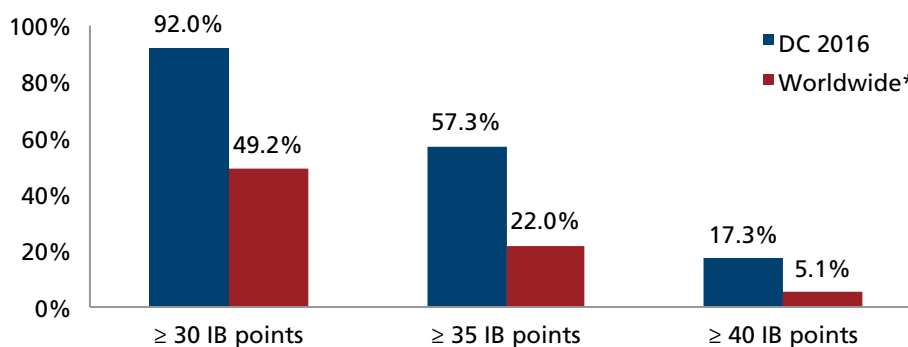
Percentage of IB Diploma Students Awarded the Full IB Diploma



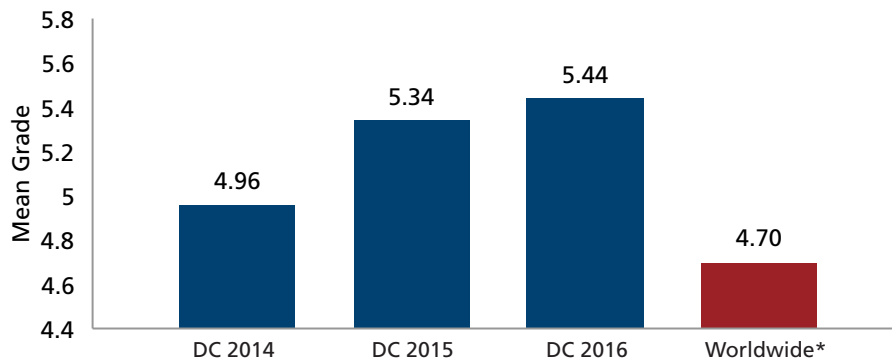
Mean Number of IB Points for IB Diploma Students
