

Summary Report of the Discovery College School Council Thursday 24 September 2015

1. 2015 Diploma Results and University Placements

Brian McCann (Diploma Coordinator/VP) presented a detailed breakdown of the 2015 Diploma results. The DC grade average for the IB Diploma exceeded the predicted score, with the increase from 2014 (32.0) to 2015 (33.9) being double that of ESF schools in their first two years of the Diploma.

Susie Blomfield (Higher Education Counsellor) outlined the final university offers to DC students. Every graduating student now has a university placement confirmed, with almost 100% of them getting either their first or second choice.

The Council expressed their appreciation to the HEC team for organising the University Fair at Discovery College on 23 September.

2. Head of Secondary

The Council members congratulated Andy Kai Fong on his recent appointment. Andy has been appointed as the establishment principal of a new K-12 school opening in NZ in January 2017.

3. Finance and Property Sub-committee

The Foreshore – The whole area is complete. The shade cloth, drinking fountains are installed and working correctly. Shade trees all planted and staked.

The P&L accounts to 31 July were approved.

4. Student Wellbeing Sub-committee

Student Counselling – Evonne Drakousis (Student Counsellor) spoke about DC's focus on Positive Psychology. The targets in our annual plan, what's been achieved so far and our aspirations going forward. Wellbeing – positive psychology - is a specific school target. Two Student Counsellors are funded through the scholarship programme – Tracey Chitty in Primary and Evonne Drakousis in secondary. There is also one government paid Social Worker.

5. Staff Wellbeing Sub-committee

New Teacher Transition – Chris and Andy have met with new teachers to gather feedback on things that worked well/could be improved not only from ESF but also DC. New staff have reported feeling very well supported and welcomed into the College. They thoroughly appreciated the welcome packs and the Mendoza Bags, and again found The Auberge an excellent place to stay on arrival.

Head of Secondary Appointment – Andy Kai Fong has resigned after 8 years in the role of Head of Secondary. The following recruitment process was approved by the Council.
