



## Y12-13 Subject Options 2020-22

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) requires students to study a wide range of subjects. All students take the core elements consisting of:

- Theory of Knowledge (ToK)
- Extended Essay (EE)
- Creativity, Action and Service (CAS)

Students must also study one subject from each of the following groups.

Group 1:	Studies in Language and Literature
Group 2:	Language Acquisition (or a second Group 1 subject)
Group 3:	Individuals and Societies (Humanities)*
Group 4:	Sciences*
Group 5:	Mathematics
Group 6:	Arts (or a second Science, a second Humanity or a third language) *A student can take two Group 6 Arts subjects if Environmental Systems and Societies is taken to cover Groups 3 and 4.

Full IB Diploma students take six subjects, three at HL and three at SL. IB Diploma Courses students take a minimum of five subjects, either at HL or SL, in order to be eligible for the Discovery College Graduation Certificate. IB Career-related Programme students take between two and four DP subjects, either at HL or SL.

The availability of subjects is **not guaranteed** at this stage. In order for a subject to be viable, there must be a minimum number of students opting for that subject.

Students currently taking Mandarin B Phase 3, 4 or 5 will be expected to continue with Mandarin B in the DP. Students currently taking Phase 1 Mandarin B are eligible for taking Mandarin Ab Initio. Students currently taking Phase 2 Mandarin B may be eligible for Mandarin Ab Initio depending on their progress in Phase 2. Moving to Spanish Ab Initio will not be automatic due to limited places in that class.
