

#### When will I get my book?

At the end of the writing process, all the stories need to be laid out and printed, which takes some time. Students will receive their books at the book launch party, where students are invited to read excerpts from their stories, do book signings and celebrate with friends and family. The book launch party this term will be held before Christmas.

What should I bring to class? While all materials will be provided, students are expected to come to class with a pencil and eraser. On the first day, students will be given a folder to keep all their work in. Students are expected to bring this folder to each lesson.
